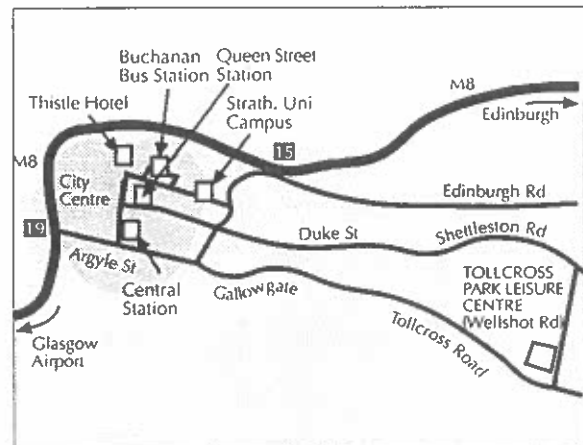

the venues

TOLLCROSS PARK LEISURE CENTRE

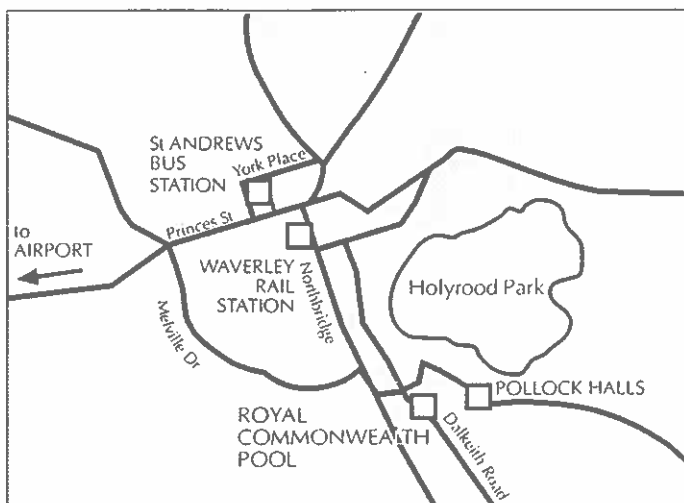
Tollcross Park Leisure Centre is situated in the heart of the East End of Glasgow. The £9.5 million Leisure Centre plays host to Scotland's first 50 metre, 10 lane "Olympic" standard pool (including the world's largest boom and moving floor), and a whole host of other hi-tec leisure facilities including Scotland's most modern state-of-the-art Gym, a luxurious Fitness Suite including Sauna, Steam Room and Spa Bath and a luxurious Fitness Studio. Other facilities include an 8 court Sports Hall, Children's Softplay (Treetops), Function Rooms and the Rendezvous Cafe for a post work-out snack!



ROYAL COMMONWEALTH POOL

The Royal Commonwealth Pool is situated 2km to the south of Edinburgh's city centre. To the north and east, the pool is dominated by Arthur's Seat, an ancient volcano steeped in Arthurian legend. The Royal Commonwealth Pool has established itself as a top international venue. It was built for the 9th commonwealth games in 1970, and host to the games once again in 1986. It is fully equipped to

deal with competitor, spectator and media demand of top flight events. The facility has a separate diving pool which has recently benefited from refurbishment. New springboards have been installed and diving platforms resuriced in preparation for the European Diving Championships to be held this year. This unique facility in Scotland has 3 fixed platforms (10m, 7.5m, 5m) and 4 maxiflex "C" springboards (2x3m and 2x1m).





training:

SWIMMING – TOLLCROSS PARK LEISURE CENTRE, GLASGOW
