**We would like to take the opportunity herewith to inform all Clubs and their Federations that LEN signed a new lucrative deal with Mikasa Corporation, therefore starting from this coming season the official ball of the European Water Polo Club Competitions will be MIKASA. Further details and relevant contacts for ordering will follow soon. Special prices will be offered to all participating clubs by Mikasa Sport AG.**

As usual all clubs and all involved Federations will receive via priority mail a book of extensive information relating to the 2008-2009 European Water Polo Club season. This info-kit should reach you, depending on the mail service, latest by mid-September. It will contain all relevant contact numbers of clubs, delegates and referees. If needed please do not hesitate to contact the LEN Office via phone, fax or e-mail should you need the contact numbers beforehand.

We would like to remind you as well that clubs organising a Qualification Round are responsible for the air travel of the delegates and referees on economy class, cover the hotel expenses on full board basis in single room in first class hotel for the same and extend a per diem of 60.- € per each delegate and referee for each day of the event plus one (1) before and one (1) after. (This per diem is to cover any additional charges that may occur to the officials as may be, i.e. car parking charges at their home airport, transport from their home to the airport if the airport is in the city of residence, extra charges in the hotel for dry cleaning, snacks, etc. that must be paid upon departure).

We remind you also that the visiting teams are to pay their own travel and accommodation costs. Organising clubs may propose and recommend hotels to the visiting teams but the final decision regarding accommodation has to be taken only by the visiting team. It is advisory that all booking procedures are dealt in writing. Organising clubs are to arrange all local transport for delegates, referees and clubs including transfer from and to the nearest airport upon arrival respectively departure, in addition naturally from hotel to swimming pool and back for training and competition.

Hope all these information are for some use to you. We take this opportunity to express our sincere thanks in advance for your collaboration, wishing you all success for the new European Water Polo Club Cup Competition season.
